



Types of Work Based Learning

Job Shadow

- Unpaid
- One day to learn more about the profession

Internship

- Unpaid
- Up to 3 days a week to gain experience

Co-Op

- Paid
- Up to 5 days a week on the jobsite
- Instead of attending CMTHS, you go to work

Co-Op and Internship Requirements

A recommendation from the student's instructor(s)

Attendance rate of 95% or better

An 85% grade or better in the student's CMTHS Program

The student must have no major disciplinary issues

Completed 6 marking periods in the same program.

Have transportation to and from their Co-Op Placement.

Must have a Social Security Card & a Work Permit (if under 18)

What Can I Do Now to Prepare for WBL?

The same thing you would do for ANY job:



Attendance – great attendance and be on time (punctuality)



Work Ethic – initiative, responsibility, reliability



Networking – join clubs and organizations, say "yes"



Skills & Knowledge – become an expert at your trade



Portfolio – gather photographs, information and documents



Driver's License – get permit, pass test
